

COVID Vaccine Registration

Even if you are eligible for receiving a vaccine, an appointment may not be immediately available to you due to significantly limited vaccine availability. New Jersey has developed an extensive network of vaccination sites to serve those currently eligible for vaccination but vaccine supply is still very limited and will be for some time.

NJ Vaccine Scheduling System: 3 ways to register for COVID Vaccine

1) **PRE-REGISTER THROUGH NJ SYSTEM:** [Enroll in the New Jersey Vaccine Scheduling System.](#)

- Go to the following link: <https://covidvaccine.nj.gov/> to pre-register. (an email address is required)
- You can reserve your spot to get a vaccine now by pre-registering. You will have to answer some questions to determine when you are eligible to receive a vaccination.
- Filling out the form should take about 15 minutes, and the information you enter will be kept private with the State of New Jersey.

You will first be notified when you become eligible for the vaccine and you will be notified again when an appointment is available to you through the scheduling system. This online portal enables eligible individuals to schedule an appointment when one is available.

2) **DIRECT REGISTRATION WITH SITES**

- There are numerous sites throughout the state that are currently administering the vaccine to [eligible individuals](#).
- You can [reach out directly to a site near you to attempt to schedule an appointment](#). Please note that many of these sites may be fully booked.

3) **VA FACILITY**

Veterans who receive care from VA health facilities, Veterans who live in VA long-term care facilities, and VA health care personnel may be eligible for vaccines through the VA. You will be contacted when a vaccine is available to you at your local VA health facility. The VA plans to eventually offer a free COVID-19 vaccine to all Veterans receiving health care through the VA.
