- Provided Council and Public project overview at June 17<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting
- Public Hearings & possible Adoption of Bond Ordinances at July 1st Council Meeting
- If approved on July 1st there is a 20-day estoppel period after the date of publication

  - Mt. Vernon (Broadway to Patterson)




- Police Building

  - Anticipate Bidding project in June 2025

  - Start construction September 2025

- First Ave Pedestrian Bridge




