

Construction of upgrades and improvements to the City of Cape May, FY2025 New Jersey Water Bank Nos. 0502001-005 & S340258-03 Sanitary Sewer & Water System Improvements with a project cost of \$5,989,622.00 will be financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits and safe drinking water for residents and businesses in the following areas:

- 1. Ohio Avenue (Reading Avenue to Philadelphia Avenue)
- 2. Stockton Place (Beach Avenue to Columbia Avenue)
- 3. Washington Street (Sidney Avenue to Lafayette Street)
- 4. Idaho Avenue (Pittsburgh Avenue to Reading Avenue)
- 5. Illinois Avenue (Pittsburgh Avenue to Michigan Avenue)
