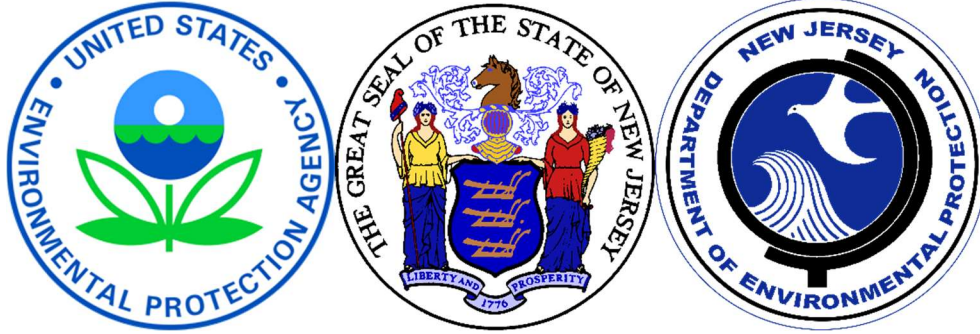




Construction of upgrades and improvements to the City of Cape May, FY2026 New Jersey Water Bank Nos. S340258-04 Various Sanitary and Water Main Improvements with a project cost of \$2,667,400 were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits and safe drinking water for residents and businesses in the following areas:

1. Howard Street (Sewell Avenue to Kearney Avenue)
2. Virginia Avenue (Philadelphia Avenue to Pittsburgh Avenue)
3. Reading Avenue (Virginia Avenue to Ohio Avenue)
4. Harbor Lane (Texas Avenue to end)
