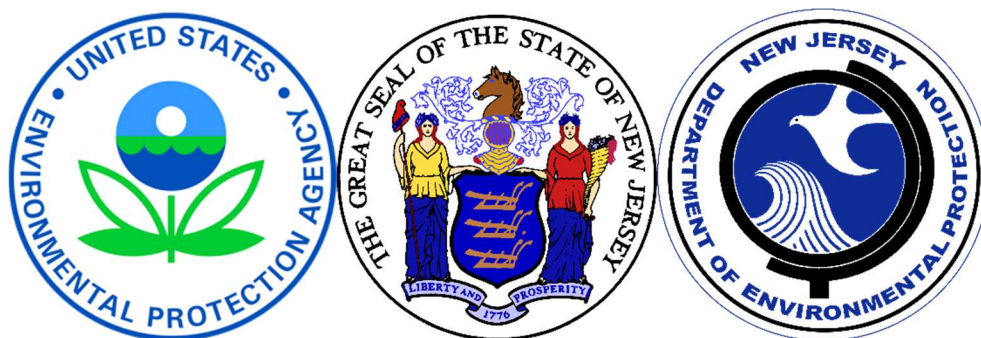




Construction of upgrades and improvements to Water Treatment Plant – Phase IA were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits for residents and businesses in Cape May City, NJ by replacing an existing water treatment plant that is nearing the end of its useful life and no longer meeting water capacity demands. New Water Treatment Plant is part of a multi-phase project that will provide a reliable source of water for treatment, storage, and use for domestic and firefighting purposes.
