Bond Deposit: A \$350.00 bond deposit is required to serve as security for the repair and performance of work necessary to put the street in as good a condition as it was prior to the excavation and pavement repairs are inspected and approved.

Insurance Requirements: The applicant must provide a certificate of insurance to the City Clerk indicating liability of not less than the amount of \$500,000.00 for any one person, and property damage of not less than \$250,000.00. The insurance shall show the City as an additional insured and shall be maintained by the applicant during the period of construction or excavation.

Hold Harmless Agreement

To the fullest extent permitted by law, _____, agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Cape May, its elected and appointed officials, its agents, employees and volunteers and others working on behalf of the City of Cape May from any damage or liability sustained by any person or property arising out of the negligence of the applicant or its agents, servants and employees during the course of any construction excavation, restoration or refilling of any street. This agreement shall require the application, in the event of a claim against the City, its agents, servants and employees arising out of the applicant's construction activities, to provide the City with a legal defense and to pay any and all attorney's fees or costs incurred by the City in connection with any claims, suits or litigation which may result with the applicant's work in the streets.
