POOL RULES

Welcome to the Cape May City Elementary School Pool.

Please observe the following rules:

- Enter pool area through locker rooms only.
- · Persons using the pool are not permitted in other areas of the school.
- . All bathers must shower before entering the pool.
- Any person showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, or any other communicable disease shall be denied admission.
- Any person with excessive suntum, open blisters, cuts, or bandages shall be denied admission.
- Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs or symptoms of a gastreintestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven days.
- All children in dispers must wear plastic pants with usug fitting elastic waist and leg bands. Do not wash out solled dispers in the bathing water.
- Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water.
 Immediately report any "accidents" you observe in the bathing waters to a lifeguard.
- Bottles, glass and other hazardous objects are prohibited within the pool area or bathroom facilities.
- . All children in the pool area must have adult supervision.
- No person shall bring or throw into the pool, walkways, uisles, or locker rooms, any object that may in any way endanger the safety of any person.
- . NO DIVING is permitted into the pool.
- No running in the post or locker room areas.
- No rough play is permitted in the pool area except for supervised water sports.
- Any person suspected of heing under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited from entering the pool.
- . Consumption of food or beverages in the swimming pool is forbidden.
- All animals with the exception of guide animals for the handicapped are prohibited from entering the pool area.
- Absolutely no smoking anywhere in this building or on these grounds.

Failure to obey directions from the lifeguard on duty will result in removal from the pool.
