

## Be Safe - Be Courteous Share the Road!

ON FOOT = FACE (go against) Traffic • ON WHEELS = (go) WITH traffic  
 CARRY ID and (MEDICAL) on person!  
 Add "ICE" InCaseEmergency" to cellphone contacts.

### MOTORISTS: Be alert

- Bicyclers have the right to ride in the street.
- IT'S NJ LAW. Stop for pedestrians in the crosswalk.
- IT'S NJ LAW. Don't pass a bike within 4'.
- Watch out for bicyclers when you open your car door.



### WHAT'S A SHARROW?

Sharrows are used to guide bicyclists on streets that don't have bike lanes. They're a simple reminder to car drivers and bicyclists to share the road!

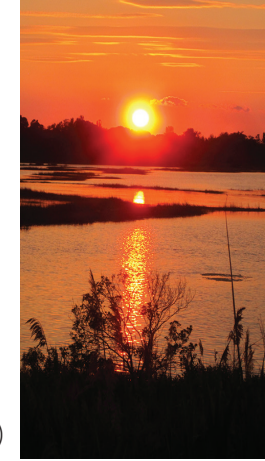

 13 acres. Encircling boardwalk (new 2019)
- 7 GARRETT FAMILY PRESERVES** Off Broadway - 108 Wilson St, Lower Twp  
 4 miles grass trails: free parking & bathroom
- 8 BIKE & WALKING PAVED PATH**  
 Connector to Middle Twp Bike Path (8.9 miles), to Cape May County Park & Zoo.

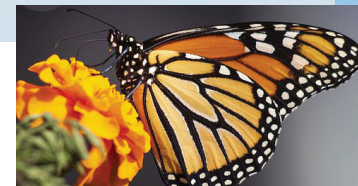
