Be Safe - Be Courteous Share the Road!

ON FOOT = FACE (go against) Traffic • ON WHEELS = (go) WITH traffic CARRY ID and (MEDICAL) on person! Add "ICE" InCaseEmergency" to cellphone contacts.

MOTORISTS: Be glert

- Bicyclers have the right to ride in the street.
- IT'S NJ LAW. Stop for pedestrians in the crosswalk.
- IT'S NJ LAW. Don't pass a bike within 4'.
- Watch out for bicyclers when you open your car door.

BICYCLISTS: Be alert to Cars and Pedestrians. Subject to same laws as a NJ motor vehicle driver.

- OBEY all traffic signs and signals.
- ALWAYS ride in the same direction as traffic.
- No cell phone usage.
- At night, use front and rear lights.
- BIKE single file in traffic.
- Use HAND SIGNALS when turning or stopping.
- WEAR a HELMET, it might save your life. Under 17: NJ Law.
- While riding, keep 3+ feet distance from parked cars.
- WEAR bright, visible and reflective clothing.
- Use your bell or horn to announce your presence.
- No drinking and riding.
- No carrying a passenger on your single bike. NJ Law
- Bicycles should not ride on sidewalks except for safety yield to pedestrians.

PEDESTRIANS: Be alert to Cars and Bicyclists.

- ALWAYS use the sidewalks when available.
- NJ Law: WITHIN Crosswalks, you have the right of way but be cautious.
- OBEY WALK / DON'T WALK traffic lights.
- A bicyclist walking a bike has all pedestrian rights.
- At night, carry a light and wear light colored clothing.
