ORDINANCE NO. 572-2025

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 OF THE CAPE MAY CITY CODE
REGARDING METERED PARKING AND INCORPORATING THE OCEANVIEW
PARKING LOT PURSUANT TO THE CITY USE AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, Chapter 7 of the Cape May Municipal Code governs vehicle and traffic regulations in the City of Cape May; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No.210-06-2025, the City of Cape May authorized a parking lot use agreement with Ocean View Restaurant, Inc. for the use of Oceanview's parking lot at 235 Beach Avenue, Cape May for public parking while the restaurant is not open for business. The lot will be made available for public parking through the City's Park Mobile program subject to the right of use reserved to the City and Cape Island under the Agreement. Under the Agreement, the City reserves discretion and authority to determine the duration and cost for metered parking at the Lot; and

WHEREAS, after review by the City Administration, the Cape May City Council desires to make amendments to incorporate the Oceanview parking lot within the City's metered parking ordinances; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Cape May in the County of Cape May and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 7 of the Cape May City Code is hereby amended to include the following NEW SUBSECTION:

§ 7-45.9. Additional metered parking areas (Three hour limit).

Three Hour Time Limit Metered Parking April 1 to October 31

2:00 PM – 10:00 PM daily based on days and times that the Oceanview is not open for business

\$0.25 per 10 minutes or \$1.50 per hour

NO OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMITTED AT ANY TIME

Name of Parking Area	Description and Location
Oceanview Parking Lot	Block 1019, Lot 23 and located in the front and rear of the property (235 Beach Avenue) with vehicular access along Beach Avenue and Grant Street. (Note: As of the date of adoption of this subsection, a Use Agreement is in effect authorizing the City to implement metered parking at this location (Resolution No. 210-06-2025). The provisions herein are subject to the continuing effect of a Use Agreement between the City and Ocean View Restaurant, Inc.).

SECTION 2. All other ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 3. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective 20 days after final passage and publication, according to law.




