The City of Cape May Water & Sewer Utility is dedicated to providing high quality drinking water to the residents of our community.

We are awaiting results from our second round of testing on the water system. These results will tell us which path to follow to further correct these issues.

Work will resume to remove the water main on Trenton between Maryland and Idaho. Please be aware that some discoloration is expected while work is being completed on the water pipe, this is a part of the improvement process.

Your Water & Sewer Department is working daily to fix the water issues on Maryland Ave. A multifaceted plan of action is being deployed. To date, an unused water main was capped off on Trenton Ave and a new fire hydrant installed on Pittsburgh and Maryland. Experts and consultants in both the science and engineering fields are assisting. Early tests look much better, we are currently waiting on precise test results. We understand that 'much better' is not the end goal. Please be aware some discoloration is expected while work is being completed on the water pipe, this is a part of the improvement process.

We are encouraged by the early results and will update everyone with all updates. We appreciate your patience and please know we will not be satisfied until the situation is fully corrected.
